Navigation Crews are strategic task forces based around the 10 Technology Priority Areas (TPAs) selected for Central Europe. They were created by experts and practitioners coming from partners teams and partnership ecosystem to form a transnational network of innovative actors. Their purpose is to strengthen regional innovation ecosystems through enhanced knowledge exchange and joint planning of concrete, market-focused, bottom-up actions. Ten Navigation Crews have been assembled, each of them is focused on a different Technology Priority Areas. These are:

- Data Analytics, Complex Simulation and Modelling
- Machine Vision
- Predictive Maintenance
- Factory and process automation
- DI&I: Machinery
- Advanced & Smart Materials
- Industrial IoT
- Digital Marketing
- Innovation in a Circular Economy
- Design & Engineering for Additive Manufacturing

The Navigation Crews Transnational Action Plan

The Navigation Crews have defined joint cooperation and concrete pilot actions in order to finalize their strategic and action planning process. The activities are focused on mobility, transfer & cooperation actions to support the implementation of the strategy. They involve not only Project Partners, but also national and regional decision makers and SMEs representing Technology Priority Areas as well as DIHs teams from Central Europe.

S3HubsinCE has started a series of Training & Mobility actions with the aim to underpin the connection between the network of DIHs. and to enhance understanding and linkages between S3HubsinCE, PPs and their stakeholder networks. Despite COVID-19, 5 mobility actions were organized as online webinars. Their main goals were:

- to train and align Project Partners and DIH operational staff with RIS3 excellent target group stakeholders (Large Enterprises, Small and Medium Enterprises, Research and Technology Organisations) and also with policy makers, regionally and abroad.
- to enhance awareness on the topic of RIS3 and to promote collaborative engagement of Potential RIS3 Champions, with Policy-Makers s.


During these webinars partners shared knowledge, tools presented them in form of informative lectures supported by case studies and practical information. The participants were invited to exchange knowledge and address the thematic questions directly to experts originating from TPAs.



The regional Digital Innovation Hub Concept

Since the beginning of the project, S3HubsinCE has developed and used various methodology to promote transnational action plans for creating the regional Digital Innovation Hubs in each region. Project Partners and their core regional stakeholders created their Digital Innovation Hub concept and agreed international outreach and thematic relevancy associated with the region's smart specialization goals. Finally, the 10 Digital Innovation Hubs were created. This institutions act as a one-stop-shops that help companies to become

more competitive with regard to their business/production processes, products or services using digital technologies.



Project Partners Meeting

The 3rd project partners meeting was held on 13–14 May 2020. Of course, according to #stayhome rule, the meeting took place virtually. This meeting allowed Partners to discuss the workflow of WP1, WP2, the Navigation Crew's reports, the functionalities and role of Digital Integration Toolkit and the following activities. The Project Partners discussed possibilities to develop the Navigation Crew's common strategy by defining joint cooperation and concrete mobility and pilot actions. There were also a series of creative sessions, teams of experts, the so-called "Navigation Crews", under which partners established a joint schedule of regional and international activities in 10 priority technological areas. We hosted during 3rd project partners meeting representatives of JS – Angelika van Es and Mirjana Dominovic who shared with us their reflection and recommendation related to project development and implementation.








S3HubsinCE community
