

Dear friends of the sea, traditional boats, sails and seamanship skills!

This year the Festival and the regatta of traditional sailing boats in Mošćenička Draga will be held within the framework of the European project **MALA BARKA 2** from the Operative Programme Interreg Slovenia – Croatia, with the goal of conducting a tourist valorisation of the maritime, fishing and shipbuilding heritage of the northern Adriatic through the creation of new tourist products. The leading partner of the project is the Primorsko-Goranska County, and the holder of manifestations is the Kvarner Tourist Board. Besides the other Croatian partners, the Maritime and History Museum of the Croatian Littoral in Rijeka and the Ecomuseum Batana, the Slovenian partners are the Municipality Izola, Izola Tourist Board, the Municipality Piran and the Maritime Museum Sergej Mašera Piran.

The organizers of the manifestation are the Ecomuseum Mošćenička Draga in cooperation with the Chair of the Chakavian Assembly of the Municipality Mošćenička Draga (Section for Traditional Boats Draga Boats), the Tourist Board and the Municipality Mošćenička Draga, as well as the Coordination of Associations for the Preservation and Revitalization of the Maritime, Fishing and Shipbuilding Heritage of Kvarner and Istria.

This year's manifestation, the **10th Festival and regatta of traditional sailing boats – MALA BARKA**, offers a rich and interesting programme, which besides a very attractive regatta with about thirty traditional wooden boats like *guc*, *pasara*, *gajeta*, *leut*, *batana* and others equipped

with traditional sails (lug sail, Lateen sail, gaff sail, dipping lug sail), also includes the exhibition race of the traditional boats accompanied by music, the review of traditional boats sailing at night in front of the quay in Mošćenička Draga accompanied by light effects and music, thematic exhibitions and lectures, as well as interesting workshops of traditional shipbuilding and sailor, nautical and fishing skills workshops. We should point out the presentation of boats that were restored as a part of the project **MALA BARKA 2**.

Besides the part of the programme intended for the presentation of the maritime heritage, the manifestation will also bring artistic events and fireworks from the sea. At the opening ceremony of the manifestation, the organizers of the Festival and the regatta in Mošćenička Draga will be awarded by the Coordination of Associations for the Preservation and Revitalization of the Maritime, Fishing and Shipbuilding Heritage of Kvarner and Istria for their special contribution in the preservation and revitalization of maritime, fishing and shipbuilding heritage. This will be followed by the formal inauguration of the fishing boat Sv Andria from 1934, restored as a part of the project **MALA BARKA 2**.

In the framework of the manifestation, there will be a fair of Kvarner eco-ethnic products and fishing nights with food and drinks, while the restaurants will be offering dishes based on autochthonous ingredients of Kvarner.

We would hereby like to invite all friends of the sea, traditional boats, sails and seafaring skills to join us and enjoy in this attractive manifestation and the holiday of our maritime heritage together with us.

KVARNER

Another name for Primorsko-Goranska County, is one of Croatia's most developed and attractive tourist destinations. 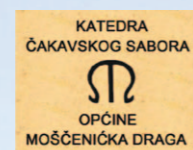
