







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Report of the WORKSHOP n. 2: "Technical workshop on the revising energy plan: presentation of the top three selected project"

Deliverable DT1.2.5 of the project ENES-CE, Municipality of Forlì (IT)

On the 20th and 22nd of May 2020 was held the 2nd Workshop meeting in the frame of the project ENES-CE. The Municipality of Forlì through its in-house society FMI s.r.l. organized the event to fulfil the objective proposed within the project. The event took place in the form of web-meeting and the professional figure previously selected to help the planning of the participating path moderated the two sessions of the meeting.

The first step of the event saw the participation of several environmental associations active on the territory of Forlì already involved during the 1st ENES-CE Workshop, whereas the second involved the economic actors and authorities of the territory: trade associations, regional environmental and health agencies, local district heating and water net provider, local public transport, banks. The second group of stakeholders have been invited by sending them an e-mail explicative of the foreseen participative path, with attached an invitation signed by the council member and a video-invite realized by the moderator which is a professional communication expert; all of them have been asked to appoint a person to follow the proposed activity. Not every contacted organisation could attend the WS2, but every institution which provided an answer and designated a person will be considered in the next follow-up activities.

Beside the designation of a contact person, the organisations have been requested to answer a short questionnaire in order to communicate their three most important reasons to be engaged in the participative path toward the SECAP. The elaboration of the collected data permitted to set a descending order of relevance and to draw the following graph:



During the meeting every representative have been asked to explain his or her point of view about the main issues related to the SECAP and in particular to express their suggestions to the actions to be included in the new SECAP. The discussion lead to different aspects of a sustainable way to use the energy in respect of the environment focusing on photovoltaic power systems, buildings energy refurbishment, mobility, national and local incentives, role of the existing Energy Help Desk, coordination of the SECAP to the other planning documents necessary to the Administration, etc.

After that, the pilot project foreseen by the ENES-CE project for the City of Forli have been presented and the participants agreed with the selection of the three main themes proposed for the Energy Consumer Purchasing Group:

- 1. high-efficiency LED Lamps or other equipment for monitoring and controlling the energy consumption at home (e.g. smart meters, thermo-hygrometer, chrono-thermostat, etc.);
- 2. high-efficiency electrical appliances;
- 3. E-bikes, bicycles, electrical kick scooter for a less impacting mobility.

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By the end of year 2020, an initial group of interested people will start the activities with the coordination of the Energy Help Desk: the team will choose one item from one of the three main themes in respect of the group's needs and will start the process of joining the demand, which will allow to get better offers on the market.

In conclusion, have been listed the indicators proposed by the Region to monitor the SECAP Actions and in particular to measure their impact on the sides of the mitigation and adaptation to the climate changes. Such a set of parameters will necessarily be considered in the next phase of proposal of the actions to be included in the next SECAP.

Both the meetings ended with the request to help fulfilling the descriptive forms for every action of the SECAP with the stakeholder's most relevant arguments. A technical meeting with some experts in the field of sustainable energy and climate will be organized and the two groups will be joined in the same path towards the new SECAP.
