Summary description of the implemented training measure(s), explaining the specific goal(s), target groups and transnational added value

Trainings for vulnerable citizens groups were conducted on February, 2021. The specific objective of the training session was to train the representatives from vulnerable population groups on how to read the information received and how to face SAPEs according to specific target needs.

The scope of the training included:

1) air quality: what does smog (London and Los Angeles type) depend on, what is low emission, air pollution levels, substances monitored by the National Environmental Monitoring stations under the supervision of the Chief Inspector of Environmental Protection.

3) basic information on the AWAIR project and communication channels

4) general presentation of AWAIR air quality monitoring system, mitigation and adaptation measures

5) the impact of air quality on health: respiratory, blood and nervous diseases, impact on the development of the fetus, allergies.

6) air protection - each of us can improve air quality. Changing communication habits, ecological heating systems, renewable energy sources.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, classes were held online. There were 4 groups sessions for vulnerable groups. Each session lasted 120 minutes. The workshops participants of vulnerable groups, like youth, seniors, people with asthma or allergies, people with chronic cardiac or respiratory diseases, pregnant woman, diabetics and school teachers were provided with information about problems of air quality and its impact on people health and how to face SAPEs, concerning mitigation and adaptation activities. During the training, participants were asked to fill in a questionnaire on air quality in Katowice FUA, their lifestyle and mobility, availability of air quality information, awareness health effects and possible sources of air pollution, actions to improve the air quality and actions taken when pollution standards are exceeded. Participants have been involved in rising air pollution awareness and gave active feedback thanks to contesting about air pollution. Participants received a certificate of participation in the AWAIR training.

Expected impact and benefits of the trainings for the concerned territories and target groups

The vulnerable groups received information's and knowledge about the air quality impact on health and how to improve air quality by themselves. The participants learned about the principles of operation of AWAIR tools, such as the "Interreg SAPEs app" and AWAIR air quality monitoring system in KATOWICE FUA. They found them useful tools for reducing exposure to air pollution and protecting health during SAPE.

The training materials were made available after the event and, together with the guidance document, provide sufficient support to transfer knowledge to vulnerable citizens. These tools can be adapted to the needs of schools and provide information to students and teachers.

Sustainability of the training(s) and developed training material(s) and their transferability to other territories and stakeholders

Further online trainings and workshops are also planned for a larger number of participants. Due to the size of the region, training courses can be conducted throughout the entire Silesian region. The AWAIR Stakeholder Group in KATOWICE FUA will continue the transfer of knowledge to vulnerable citizens.

This training could be transferred to other territories and other stakeholders facing similar challenges. The slides presented in the training together with the "Handbook" (D.T3.1.1) constitute a complete training package applicable in the future to other interested parties. The developed training materials and presentations are published on the AWAIR website and made available through it to other interested users after registration. Lecture and training materials will remain available and are likely to be updated by different users over time.
