

Workshop on Porcelain Moulding Process

Summary

CerDee project partner MIC in cooperation with FACC (Faenza Art ceramic Center) reported a workshop focusing on the moulding process of porcelain. Founded in September 1908 by Gaetano Ballardini, the International Museum of Ceramics or MIC Faenza, is one of the most important ceramic museums in the world. Regularly, MIC organizes many events such as exhibitions, restorations of ceramics, cultural or scientific activities, educational workshops, and educational and exhibition supports. Meanwhile, FACC is an international centre dedicated to the promotion and enhancement of art and ceramics in particular.

The aim of this workshop was to create unique objects starting from a casting or pressure mould, simplifying the manufacturing processes. A total of 8 participants took part in the workshop laboratory. The participants come from different backgrounds of knowledge about business and ceramics, few of the participants already have their ceramic studio, and others are planning to open a business.
