| <b>Expected effects and follow-up, findings/conclusions that will contribute to achieving further project results</b> | <p>We presented the project activities to small celiac society CeliVita from Zagreb as well as to regional HCPs dealing with celiac disease. We promoted the e-tools, for patients and HCPs, presented the pilot activities of both societies and hospitals - rapid testing, mentoring service for newly diagnosed patients as well as new CD diagnostic methods, new approaches and innovative comprehensive CD management model, which will be presented to Ministries as a policy recommendation paper. Zagreb “partners” will use and spread our achievements, which will assure sustainability and transferability.</p> <p>It was a CeliVita 5<sup>th</sup> birthday, that we celebrated with the education and dissemination event. Society representative gave an introduction speech and presented the development and achievements of the small CeliVita society, which has 183 members from the region and performed a lot of activities. PP2 UKC MB representative, Jernej Dolinšek presented e-tools for patients and new ESPGHAN celiac disease guidelines as well as a part of celiac disease management assessment results (diagnostic delays). A CD management model was presented to participants. LP gave an overview of pilot activity “Mentoring service for newly diagnosed patients”, PP6 representative Marina Milinovič gave a lecture about their pilot activity “Rapid testing of school children Primorsko-goranska county”. Goran Palčevski held a lecture about celiac disease management assessment results (HCPs knowledge in Croatia).</p> <p>We established a long-term cooperation.</p> <p>The programme is attached.</p> |              |       |                        |  |  |   |








| <b>Topics tackled and description of links to deliverables/outputs</b> | <p>We (KW and AB) presented our e-tools to the colleagues working in pediatric gastroenterology tertiary care (university hospital's setting) at Charité Berlin and discussed their use and implementation in their center, addressing advantages and challenges according to their setting.</p> <p>First of all, we presented the e-tools for patients D.T.2.2.2 (German: Online-Kurs "Zöliakie verstehen" für Betroffene). The colleagues from Berlin were very impressed and judged that this tool is perfect to train the patients either as self-educative tool or alternatively - in cases with parents who have a lower capability to inform themselves sufficiently - to use it during explaining celiac disease in their practice.</p> <p>The upcoming e-learning for HCPs and the Web-App was highly appreciated by Prof. Bufler, head of the children's hospital and pediatric gastroenterologist, to use it as training tools particularly for the young physicians who are not familiar with celiac disease yet, but also for the specialists to update their knowledge according to the brand new guidelines which will be published soon.</p> <p>Finally, we presented the pilot project D.T.3.2.9 comprising 1) the transition workshop for adolescents with celiac disease and 2) the celiac passport to document the diagnosis and the monitoring of celiac disease. Regarding the passport the Berlin team was very happy to get such an updated tool which is based on the upcoming guidelines already and, including much more gimmicks than the old version which they had so far not used in their practice. They particularly liked the idea of additional information about celiac disease in the passport (to inform other, less well-informed physicians about celiac disease) and the plastic-"celiac-Id-card" which is included in the back of the passport and can be signed by the diagnosing doctor which allows the patient to always easily take it with her or him and to show it in situations as restaurants or in the hospital etc.</p> <p>Regarding the transition programme, they are currently enhancing their collaboration with their social pediatric center (SPZ) at the children's hospital and do see a realistic possibility to implement such a workshop as well which they consider very important. The team confirmed that they do</p> |

| <p><b>Expected effects and follow-up, findings/conclusions that will contribute to achieving further project results</b></p> | <p>The team at the pediatric gastroenterology of the Charité Berlin highly appreciated all our project outputs and were very enthusiastic and grateful to get these tools for their daily patient care as well as education of their young medical doctors in training.</p> <p>They confirmed that they will use the tools immediately, respectively will start implementing a transition workshop when the new structures in their hospital will have being settled.</p> <p>Unfortunately, few colleagues of the division could not attend due to illness (MA) or had to leave our workshop earlier than expected due to an emergency in patient care (SH and MP) during the workshop. | <b>Summary of discussed topics/presentation of project results</b>  | <p>This meeting had presentations about the Focus in CD project, but also an informal discussion before and after the presentations with Slovak health providers and public health experts about different situations in these neighbouring countries. The programme of the seminar/workshop was announced on the webpage of the university and attracted considerable attention also among medical students. Our host is also involved in the steering of the local celiac society, so also patient-side interest was raised.</p> <p>In the first presentation, Ilma Korponay-Szabo spoke about the Focus in CD project and celiac diagnostic issues and challenges. Also presented the survey results obtained in the WP1.</p> <p>Then Judit Gyimesi explained the e-tools and demonstarted the English version them online. Also showed the intro and pathogenesis videos, which raised attention especially among the students who also attended the meeting. All felt they are clear and understandable, and enjoyed animation very much. Everybody was in good mood.</p> <p>In the thrid part, pilots were introduced by Ilma Korponay-Szabo, more specifically the screening results of family members. A spart of this, the genetic background of coeliac disease was explained.</p> |
| <b>Expected effects and follow-up, findings/conclusions that will contribute to further collaboration</b> | <p>During the discussions, we learned that in Slovakia, the no-biopsy celiac diagnosis is not yet implemented, as social support is only given to patients diagnosed by biopsy. So traditionalk diagnosis is still compuslory and doctors do not feel yet confident also from medical viewpoint with a serology only diagnosis. They trust more histology. Further, we learned tha in this country, most paediatric gastroenterologists who perform biopsies are private, but they get reimbursement from the national health insurance, Since the country is small, referrals are made by the primary care doctors to doctors accoridng to the preference of gthe patients - no restrictive territorial rules exist. Screening of family members occurs, but a regular screening id not performed. They have access to insurance-based laboratory tests of satisfying quality. The life of patients is supported in mayn ways, although gluten-free items are still much more expoensive for them as would be normal food. The local team warmly welcomed us and</p>  |
