

The problem





- A rapidly ageing population, especially in the Central European region
- Increased demand for home care
- Not enough carers
- Need to digitise home care services
- Problem: low uptake of digital tools by carers





Proposed solution





- Adapting the method of co-creation
- Wider use of co-creation method by SMEs and public service providers
- Strengthening cooperation between the actors of the Quadruple Helix

- Following field testing, further development of the co-creation manuals
