Summary description of the implemented training measure(s), explaining the specific goal(s), target groups and transnational added value

The training focused on identifying those results which are considered most compelling for other regions and Operators to create interest and stimulate the development of action plans, alternative fuels for the last mile logistics, and for spatial planning considering renewable energies. With this objective in mind, three training topics were identified, corresponding to specific deliverable results and to showcase the experiences of one of the pilot sites. In this way, the audience are introduced to the main content that is required for decisions as well as the experiences of those who have applied these concepts. Three trainings were organized by Unioncamere del Veneto, and were held between April and May 2022, via Zoom (with recordings) with the following topics: Assessing Alternative Fuel Concepts, Developing Action Plans for Smooth Green Nodes Development, Regional Motivations for Implementing Green Solutions. Two additional workshops were held on 10th May 2022 and 23rd June 2022 and were organized by the Integreen Hungarian Intergreen Partner Freeport of Budapest Logistics Ltd, addressing the following topics: CEF framework and possible financing of green logistics developments, AT 3.2 pilot projects: overview, implementation steps, lessons learned, opportunities to participate in supported green logistics development projects as beneficiaries. Invitations were extended across the partnership networks and reasonable participation was obtained for all events, considering the niche area of representation. All information was distributed also to the participants, as well as the survey on the events. Few questions were issued by the participants although good discussion ensued across the panel participants on the topics. The trainings proved to be an effective way to communicate technical information to help stimulate discussion and pick-up beyond the project partners. The participation of additional actors and stakeholders would have been desirable and further opportunities to share these materials will be supported by the dissemination of the materials and the availability of the partners to answer any specific questions.

Expected impact and benefits of the trainings for the concerned territories and target groups

The main objective of the workshop was twofold, on the one hand to disseminate the InterGreen project and the pilot projects implemented under it, and on the other hand to help participants to find funding opportunities for their green logistics projects, to assist them in successfully applying for and raising funds. The transnational character of the workshops was given by the presentation of good practices from the InterGreen-Nodes project, which can be adapted to other national conditions. The workshop presented the main experiences of the pilot projects, which can provide important information and help for their effective implementation in other countries. In order to ensure the most effective transfer of information, the workshops were based on personal presentations, after which participants had the opportunity to discuss the issues raised.

Sustainability of the training(s) and developed training material(s) and their transferability to other territories and stakeholders

The main objective of the workshop was the dissemination and social awareness of the good practices and results of the InteGreen-Nodes project. In addition, the events aimed at presenting the related international funding opportunities as a technology supplier for the planned projects in the next period. As a result of the workshops, participants were able to learn about the international good practices of the InterGreen-Nodes project. They were able to learn about the key factors, the implementation steps, the budget and the main lessons learned for each project. In this context, information was provided on the CEF instrument as a possible direction for financing investments. The participants received information that will help them to prepare for CEF2 calls, to participate as suppliers, to prepare potential projects and possible cooperation. They can use the experience gained in the previous period to apply for funds more effectively.
