## Enlargement of the MoU subscribers

Any Business Support Organization in the EU offering so called KIBS is entitled to join the THING+ project agreement (Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter MoU) with the purpose to adopt the SIM in its offer for the business innovation to its clients.

The MoU would-be subscribers, provided that the THINGS+ project main output Service Innovation Methodology had proven to be effective and potentially of interest for (central) European manufacturing companies, wish to learn it with the purpose to offer SIM as a standard service in their portfolio.
