
TOURISM IN








Developing CEETO Guidelines for Policy Makers and Manual for PA Managers

How to support Policy Makers and PA Managers in the integration of sustainable tourism principles in public policies and implementing tools in PA Management.

Criticalities of the <u>"Management model"</u>

- 1 Limited knowledge of the visitor profile (origin, habits, behaviour, desires, movement, etc.);
- 2 Not appropriate **tourist offer** (information and proposals);
- 3 Limited knowledge of the impacts produced by tourism on environmental and social components;
- 4 **Low participation of the stakeholders** (public-private) in the definition of proposals for the sustainable development of tourism





Criticalities of the <u>"Tourist fruition"</u>

- 1 **Limited knowledge** of the peculiarities and fragilities of the protected area;
- 2 Limited **awareness** of the **behaviours** to be adopted;
- 3 Prevailing **accessibility** to key areas by private cars;
- 4 Limited knowledge of **alternatives** and possible offers within the P.A.;
- 5 **Concentration** of tourist flows in space and time.
