

JOANNEUM RESEARCH PROVIDES TECHNOLOGY FOR THE NASA MARS 2020 ROVER

JOANNEUM RESEARCH 3D-vision expert Gerhard Paar (Institute DIGITAL) was recently staying in California at Malin Space Science Systems (MSSS) to help geometrically calibrate the Mastcam-Z instrument on Mars 2020 Rover. Mastcam-Z is a stereoscopic vision system consisting of two identical multispectral zoomable cameras with variable focus, mounted on the Rover mast.



127th MPEG MEETING: DIGITAL EXPERTS CONTRIBUTE TO STANDARDIZATION PROCESS

The 127th MPEG Meeting took place from 8 to 12 July 2019 in Gothenburg, Sweden, and was attended by more than 600 participants. The high level of interest is due to the fact that two video coding standards, Versatile Video Coding (VVC) and Essential Video Coding (EVC), are close to the adoption of the Committee Draft.

On 20 November 2019, the European Commission will launch 'due diligence ready!'. This initiative will support responsible minerals and metals sourcing. 'Due diligence ready!' is dedicated to small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) with minerals and metals in their supply chain, focusing on, but not limited to, tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold. It helps SMEs perform due diligence effectively and ensure responsible sourcing. For those impacted by regulatory requirements, for example by the <u>EU's 'conflict minerals' regulation</u>, the initiative will help them comply with their legal obligations.



WHAT ARE THE TECHNOLOGIES THAT WILL RESHAPE OUR WORLD? INDEPENDENT EXPERTS IDENTIFY 100 OF THEM
