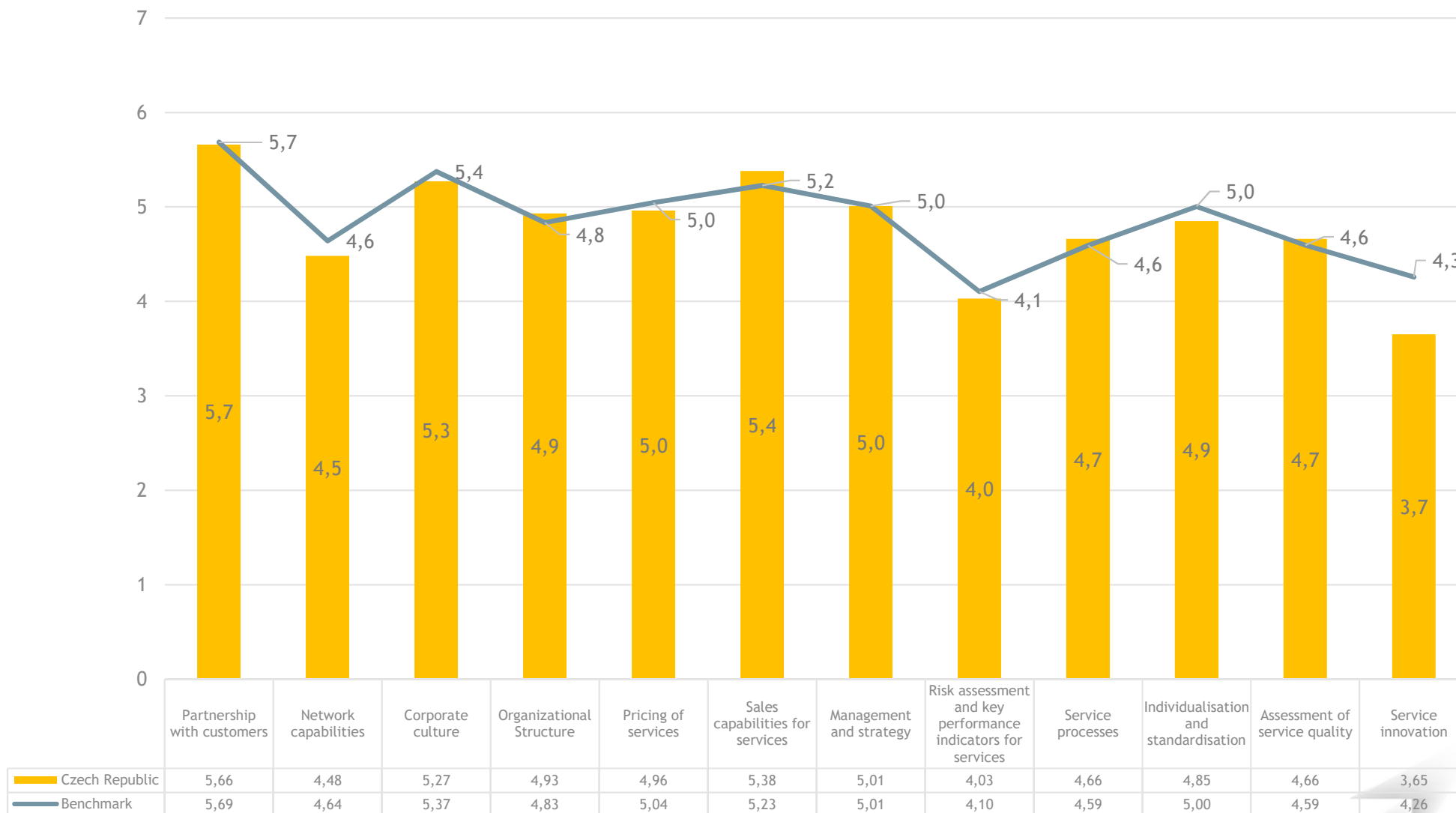

12 DIMENSIONS - BENCHMARK



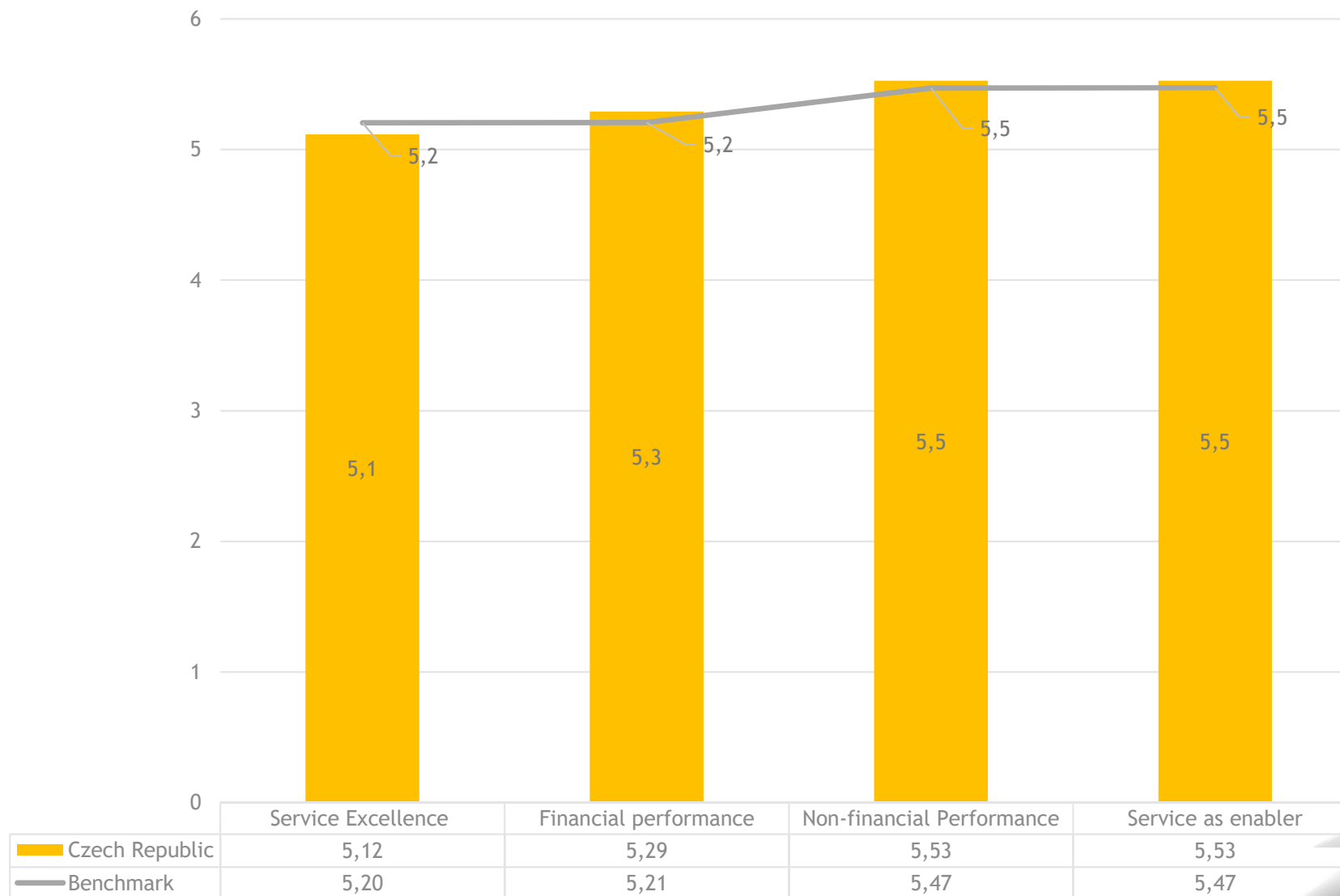

TAKING COOPERATION FORWARD

The Czech Republic is divided into 13 regions and 1 capital city.

ISE MONITOR was mostly filled in by companies from:

- The South Bohemian Region
- The South Moravian Region
- The Central Bohemian Region



Industrial production is concentrated mainly in the agglomeration of České Budějovice. In the Czech Republic, the region is not one of the most important industrial areas, the share of sales of industrial enterprises in the Czech Republic in 2016 was 4.7%. From a sectoral point of view, the manufacturing industry prevails, production of motor vehicles and food.

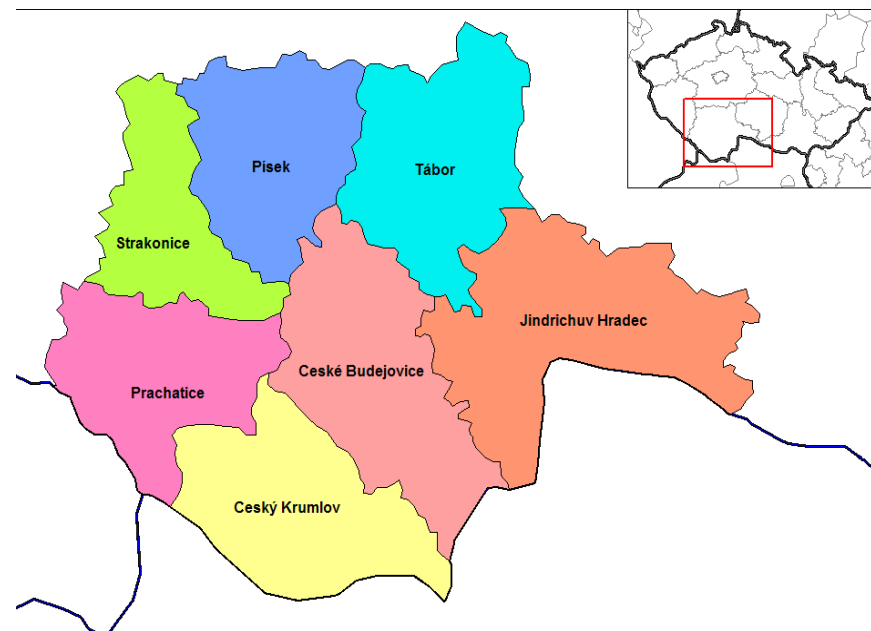

Mechanical engineering has an essential role in the economy of the region. Important centers of mechanical engineering are Brno (PBS, Siemens, Zetor Brno), Blansko (ČKD Blansko, Metra Blansko), Kuřim (TOS Kuřim), Boskovice (Minerva, Novibra) and Břeclav (OTIS). Electrical engineering has had a tradition for more than a century. Significant producers are Siemens Drásov, VUES Brno and ZPA Brno.

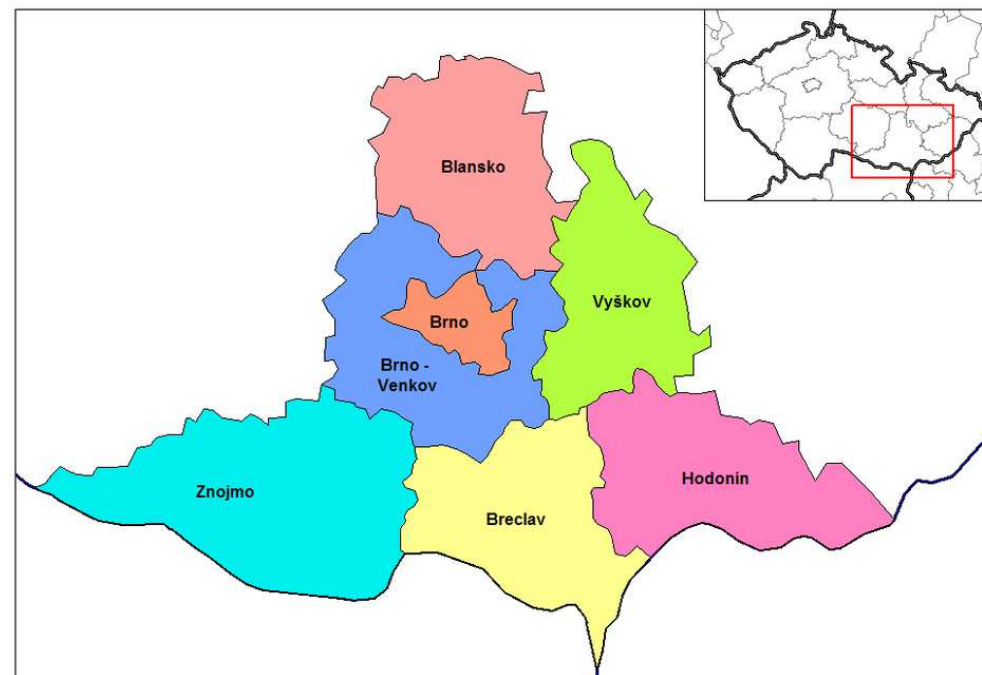

THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN REGION

The most important branches of industry in the region are mechanical engineering, chemical industry and food industry. Other significant industries are glass production, ceramics and printing. On the other hand, some traditional industries such as steel industry, leather manufacturing and coal mining have been declining in the recent period.

In 2006, 237 industrial companies with 100 or more employees were active in the region. A car manufacturer ŠKODA AUTO a.s. Mladá Boleslav became a company of nationwide importance. Another car manufacturer which is active in the region is TPCA Czech, s.r.o. in Kolín.

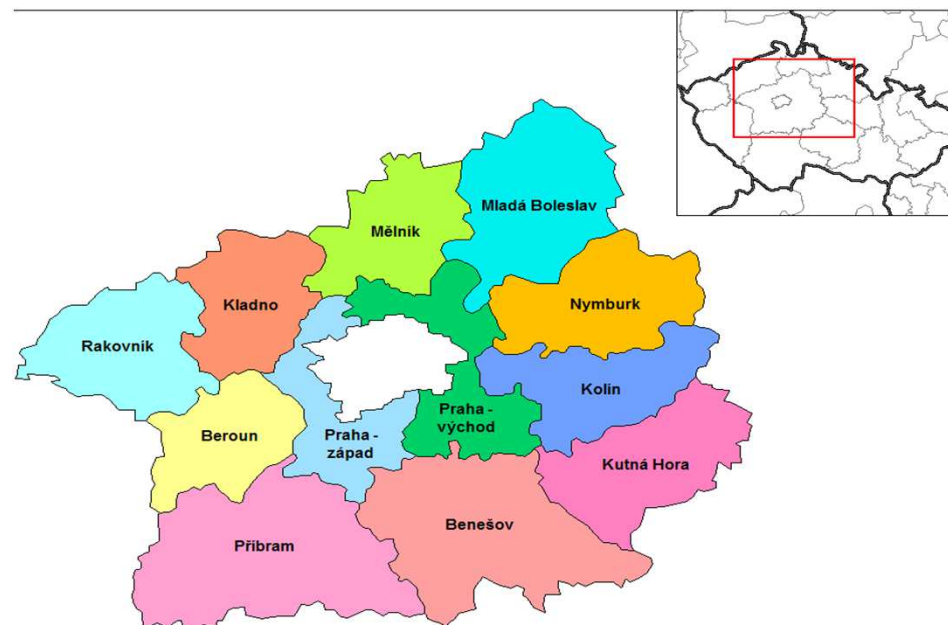
