## 1.2. Summary of the meeting

At the beginning of the meeting, Mr. Blaz Jemensek, project manager at The Prometni institut Ljubljana, presented to participants project REIF and pilot activities in the Central Slovenia region. A promotional video of REIF pilot project in Central Slovenia region (industrial siding documentation for a local car logistics centre) was also presented.

The representative of the partner Luka Koper Mrs. Tina Bizjak presented the pilot activities in logistics area of in the Port of Koper. Further a promotion video of testing cameras to identify rail freight wagons in Port of Koper was shown.

Mr. Jemensek further presented a road map with possible measures to improve rail freight transport infrastructure and services (D.T3.2.7), followed by funding needs & ensuring financial sustainability, policy measures (D.T3.2.5).

The presentations were followed by a discussion with questions from the participants of the meeting. A summary of the comments and ideas is provided below.

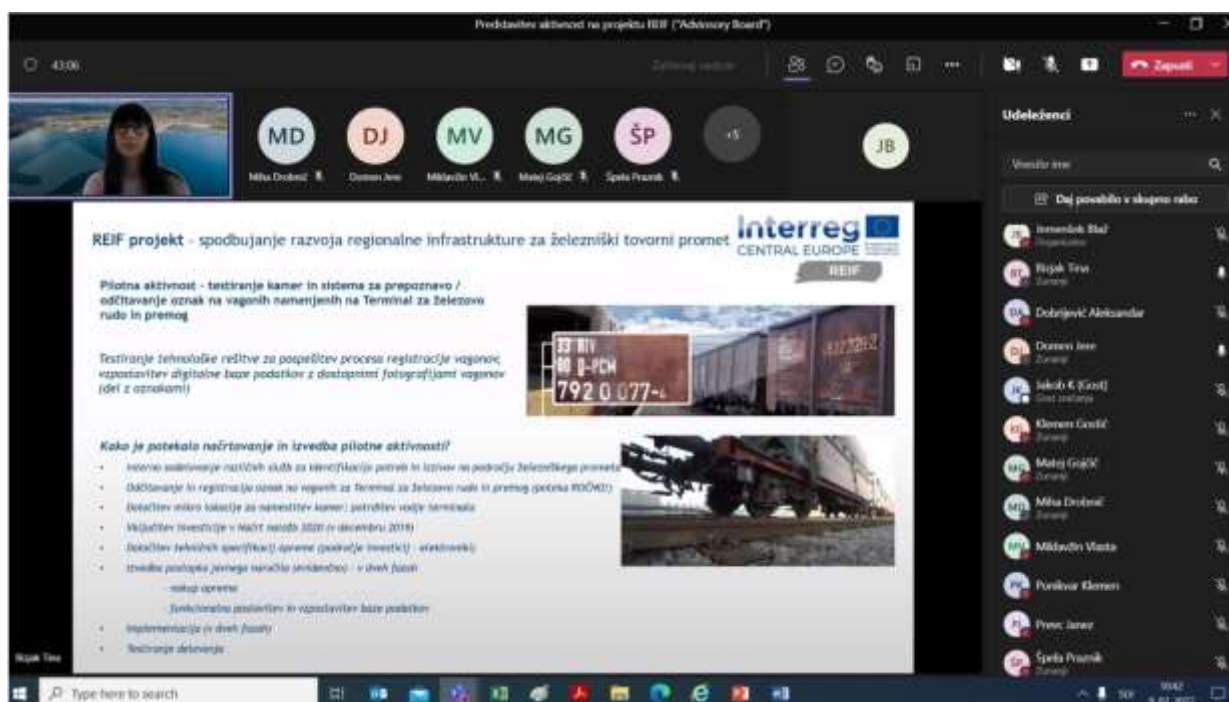
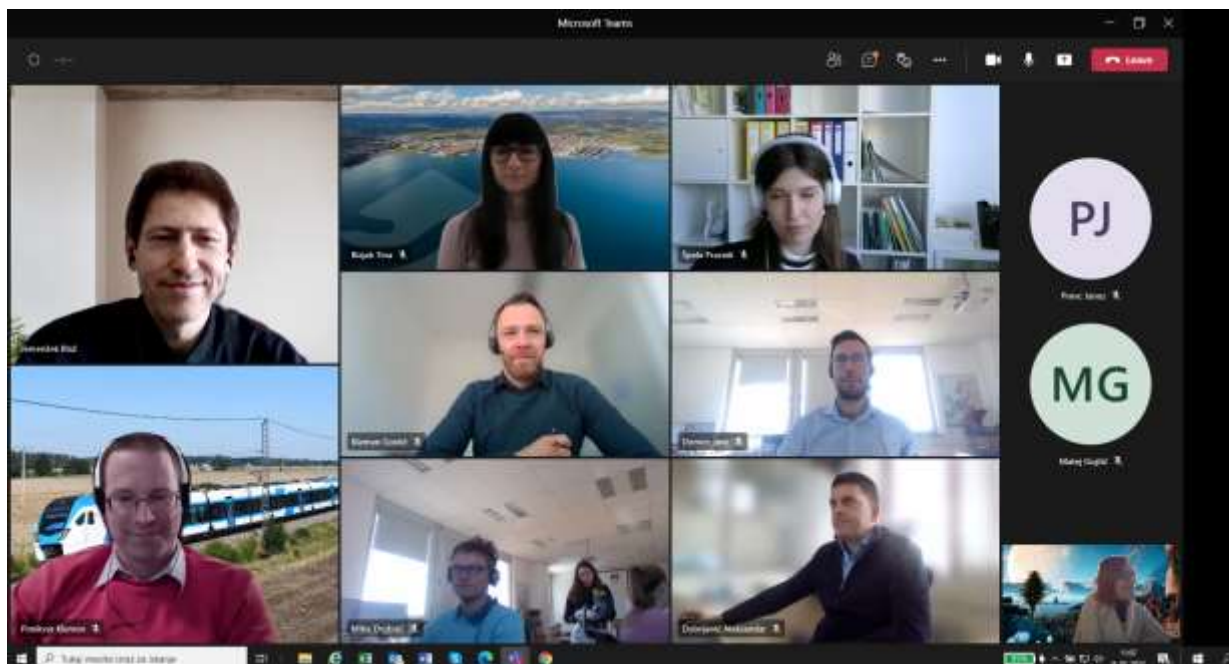
### Key findings and proposals:

- Participants agreed with the proposed measures and financing.
- The interest in co-financing of the company operating car logistics centre the construction of industrial tracks was explained. This is also linked to the environmental strategy.
- The estimated amount of investment for the construction of industrial tracks was explained.
- The idea was given for regular and permanent transport of timber from state forests by rail over long distances or to distant destinations.
