

## RegiaMobil

The District Administration Rottal-Inn is responsible for the territorial development of the NUTS III region with a size of 1280 sqm and approximately 120,000 inhabitants. The district administration coordinates and purchases public transport within its territory, and coordinates public transport beyond its territory with neighboring districts. Recently the district opened its first on-demand bus line. The district is located on the Austrian-Bavarian border. While trains service Simbach a. Inn (Germany) as well as Braunau (Austria), located across the Inn river, intermodal connections are unattractive for passengers, leading to a large number of individual motorized vehicles both on roads towards Simbach a. Inn and across the bridge to Braunau.

Rottal-Inn's activities in RegiaMobil project focus on the preparation and implementation of a demonstration project (WP T2 pilot action) capitalising outputs of two previous Central Europe projects (Rumobil's Transnational Strategy and the "ProntoBus" pilot action realized in Modena; Connect2CE's tools to support decision-making for cross-border public transport services) and considering results of the Horizon 2020 operation MaaS4EU in its planning.

The demonstration project's core is the planning and one-year pilot operation of a cross-border ondemand bus line linking rural towns in the vicinity of Simbach a. Inn to the city's and Braunau (AT) rail stations. In addition, Rottal-Inn participates in all other foreseen project activities, including study-trips (T2), tool-box elaboration (T2), review and update of the Transnational Strategy (T1), communication and management activities (WP C and WP M).
