Examples for collaboration

Workshop

An expert from your company comes to us and gives a workshop. It should be interactive and a chance to get to know our participants as well as a chance to develop for the employee. (Learning through teaching.)

Potential topics: Linux, GitHub, Testing, Maven / Gradle, Scrum, Kanban, Continuous Delivery, Docker

Projects

During the last six weeks of the program our participants are working in groups using agile methods (Scrum). Your company will provide support from an experienced Team Leader, Scrum Master or Product Owner for the time of the projects. (Time investment needed: 2 full days plus ~4h per week.)

Company Visits

We come to visit you at your office.

After a tour, the participants have the chance to ask questions to developers.



Examples for collaboration

Employability Day

Our participants present projects they worked on. Hosted by Microsoft Austria and followed by a group exercise and time for one-on-one interviews. This is the chance for you to meet many of our participants in just one day.

Mentoring

Thursday afternoon is mentor time. Experienced developers come by and support our participants in solving the exercises of the week.
