SMACKER: Soft Measures & Actions for behavioural Change and Knowledge to Embrace peripheral and Rural areas

Issues

- Peripheral and rural regions in Central Europe share the same risks and issues related to being at the periphery of main transport networks
- Main challenges: inadequate and under-used services, excessive costs, lack of last mile services and proper intermodality, poor communication and information to users and above average private car use
- SMACKER aims to address these issues promoting demand-responsive and sustainable public transport and mobility services to connect the local transport systems to the main transport corridors and nodes

SMACKER APPROACH



• 4 PILLARS

- UNDERSTANDING Capacity building of stakeholders and PPs through best practices review and sharing and specific training
- PARTICIPATION The so-called Local Mobility Forums are established by the activation of Community of Interests (road users) and Community of Practices (transport practitioners to co-design services and campaigns)
- INNOVATION New methodologies to implement pilot activities and by using innovative approaches such as nudging, gamification, co-design, marketing and branding
- IMPACT Actions are aligned with requirements and KPIs deriving from SUMPs and other strategic plans to provide a substantial and measurable contribution to strategic objectives
