1. Executive Summary

As a great part of the project has unfolded during the Covid 19 pandemics, many of the planned events involving journalists for on site visits have been reconfigured into bilateral talks to provide them with key information about the project or combined with other activities carried out to illustrate the work and results of pilot activities, in particular in the Open Innovation Week and in the Model Farm Demonstration days.

Partners have entertained regular relations with the media, especially at local and regional level. With pilot activities mostly starting or reaching maturity level in the fall and winter 2021, most partners developed audiovisual material, in combination with activities foreseen by AC6.3 on the production or local and regional videos, which was made available to local journalists through local drives.

The press was fed with regular news, through a combination of direct communication and social networks, on the progress of project activities and its conclusion.

1.1. Journalist Days in Italy

A presentation of the TRANSFARM project was integrated in the general Presentation of the EIMA 2021 edition, in meetings with the media at the AGRIUMBRIA regional fair held in Bastia Umbra between the 17-19 September, one month ahead of the main event held in Bologna on the between the 19 and 23 October. Both the CEO of FEDERUNACOMA Alessandro Malavolti and the director Simona Rapastella met a crowd of about 10 journalists on the themes of innovation in the agriculture, in particular for vineyards and orchards.

Another edition of Agriumbria took place in April 2022. FEDERUNACOMA took part in all three days. TRANSFARM 4.0 was referred to in meetings with journalists, in view of its final phases, summarizing the work done and the positive effects on the Italian machinery industry.

1.2. Journalists Days in Hungary

Meetings with journalists took place at the occasion of conferences and presentations of TRANS-FARM 4.0 activities in the viticulture sector in Hungary, mostly related to Pilot Action 3. In particular, a thorough presentation of results achieved in the project was provided at the National Conference of Viticulture and Enology at the end of May 2022, summarizing the benefit of applying precision agriculture to a high potential industry.





1.3. Journalist Days in Slovenia

Activities in Slovenia focused among others on directing messages to the general public also through interventions by Jurij Rakun of the University of Maribor in radio broadcasts at Radio Slovenija and Radio Maribor. Also, contacts were regularly entertained with the financial press, to draw attention on the positive effects of precision agriculture on the productive processes and therefore on the business health of farm enterprises.
