


















Report from workshop no. 3: "ENERGY PLANNING IN A COMMUNE WITH RESIDENTS INVOLVEMENT", on November 24, 2020 in Lubelskie Voivodeship, Poland.

Workshop meeting no. 3 in the ENES-CE project: "Presentation of new energy plans, the LCEP of the Niemce Commune updated in the bottom-up process to a wider audience" took place as part of the online meeting "Energy planning in a commune with residents involvement" on November 24, 2020.

Due to the fact that "Energetic Fair in Lublin", during which it was planned to organize workshops no. 3, was cancelled (pandemic state), Lubelskie Voivodeship organized an online meeting as part of the implementation of two projects financed from European funds: "ENES-CE" and "National consultancy support system for the public sector, the residential sector and enterprises in the scope of energy efficiency and RES".

The invitation to participate in the meeting was sent by e-mail to the authorities of 213 communes in the region, municipal energy specialists, as well as residents and other stakeholders from the Lublin Voivodship. What is more, the invitation was published on the website of the Niemce Commune.

On November 24, 2020, of 61 people that declared participation in the meeting, eventually 48 took part. They were mainly representatives, employees and residents of the following communes: Niemce, Cyców, Firlej, Goraj, Hańsk, Izbica, Komarów-Osada, Międzyrzec Podlaski, Siemień, Strzyżewice, Telatyn, Wojciechów, Wojsławice, Żółkiewka, Józefów nad Wisłą, Lubartów, Kazimierz Dolny, Siedliszcze, Susiec, Zakrzew, as well as representatives of Communal Service from the Niemce Commune, Social Assistance Centre in Niemce, the Niemce Commune Council, Service and Production Company sp. z o.o. in Hańsk and the Marshal's Office of the Lubelskie Voivodeship in Lublin.

The meeting was opened and introduced to the participants by Mr. Janusz Bodziacki - Director of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources of Marshal Office of the Lubelskie Voivodeship in Lublin. Mr. Kajetan Kościk - Head of the RES Division in the Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources and at the same time the Energy Advisor, talked about the projects implemented by the department under the Interreg Program and the Infrastructure and Environment Operational Program.

In the first part of the meeting, the expert involved in the ENES-CE project, Mr. Paweł Czupryn, presented the updated Low-Carbon Economy Plan (LCEP) for the Niemce Commune, pointing out the changes which had been introduced to the document and the project activities implemented so far, related to the updated LCEP, as well as planned activities in the commune related to the use of renewable energy and the creation of a citizen energy group under the ENES-CE project. What is more, the expert talked about the commune's priority activities and investments in renewable energy based on the tool which has been developed in the ENES-CE project.

Participants of the meeting were also presented with the purpose of the planned creation of a citizen energy group in the commune in the form of an energy cluster with the possibility to transform to energy cooperative, and the schedule of creating the energy cluster in the commune as part of the ENES-CE project in the Lubelskie Voivodeship. Moreover, the expert also presented what analyses and documents will be prepared by him for the Niemce Commune before the creation of the energy cluster.





In order to create the citizen energy group in the Niemce Commune under the ENES-CE project and to define a pilot action plan to be implemented in third stage of the project, a series of 3 workshops is planned for residents and others stakeholders, concerning to involve participants in creating a citizen energy group, where:

> The first workshop will concern:

- ❖ presentation of developed Baseline Emission Inventory (BEI), April 2020,
- indication of forms and possibilities of using BEI for energy planning and investment activities in the Niemce commune, taking into account the participation of residents and other stakeholders,

> The second workshop will concern:

- presentation of draft agreement regarding the created citizen energy group,
- presentation of Low-Carbon Economy Plan (LCEP), updated to SECAP,
- presentation of environmental education plan,
- ❖ information about a system of consulting activities with Commune Energy Engineer,
- implementation of another investment regarding the use of renewable energy and energy efficiency in the Niemce Commune,
- selection of activities to be implemented by citizens of the Niemce Commune.

> The third workshop will cover:

- signing an agreement on the creation of a citizen energy group in the Niemce Commune, by residents and other stakeholders from the area of the Niemce Commune, who decide to become the members of created group,
- signing a letter of intent regarding the decision on the selection of a pilot action in the Niemce Commune selected for implementation by the citizen energy group together with the Niemce Commune.

The first part of the meeting was closed with an open discussion about air pollution and the Central Emission Register of Buildings in Poland and information about subsequent activities to be implemented as part of the ENES-CE project, concerning the inventory of boilers and heating devices, which are the basis for obtaining financing for low-emission projects under the national programme "Stop Smog" in the future.

In the second part of the meeting, the project Energy Advisors working under "National consultancy support system for the public sector, the residential sector and enterprises in the scope of energy efficiency and RES", presented, among others, the possibilities and conditions for obtaining funds for investments in energy efficiency and renewable energy for households and local government units, under national programmes such as: "Czyste Powietrze" (Clean air), "Mój Prąd" (My Electricity) and "Agroenergia" (Agroenergy).

What is more, Energy Advisors talked about the "Stop Smog" programme and the anti-smog resolution submitted to public consultation, as well as the areas of floating dust pollution levels exceedance (PM10, PM 2.5, etc) in the Lubelskie region and air pollution levels in the Niemce Commune.

The online meeting "Energy planning in a commune with residents involvement" as part of the implementation of two connected projects gave an opportunity to reach a wider audience, show the joint energy planning possibilities on the example of the Niemce Commune and the possibility of using various sources of financing for low-emission projects and investments in renewable energy. After the workshops, all participants were given the presented materials and information brochures about the implemented project.
